

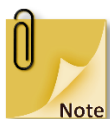


## Embed Adobe Connect Recording in D2L: Play Inline

An Adobe Connect recording can be directly embedded in any D2L page. The embedded recording has full interactivity and functionality. This method is recommended for sharing Adobe Presenter and Adobe Connect recordings. The recording will display inline:



Follow the steps below to learn one method to embed Adobe Presenter, and Adobe Connect, presentations in D2L:




Upload presentation to Adobe Connect server and copy the **URL for Viewing**

1. Create a new module, and click **Add a description**



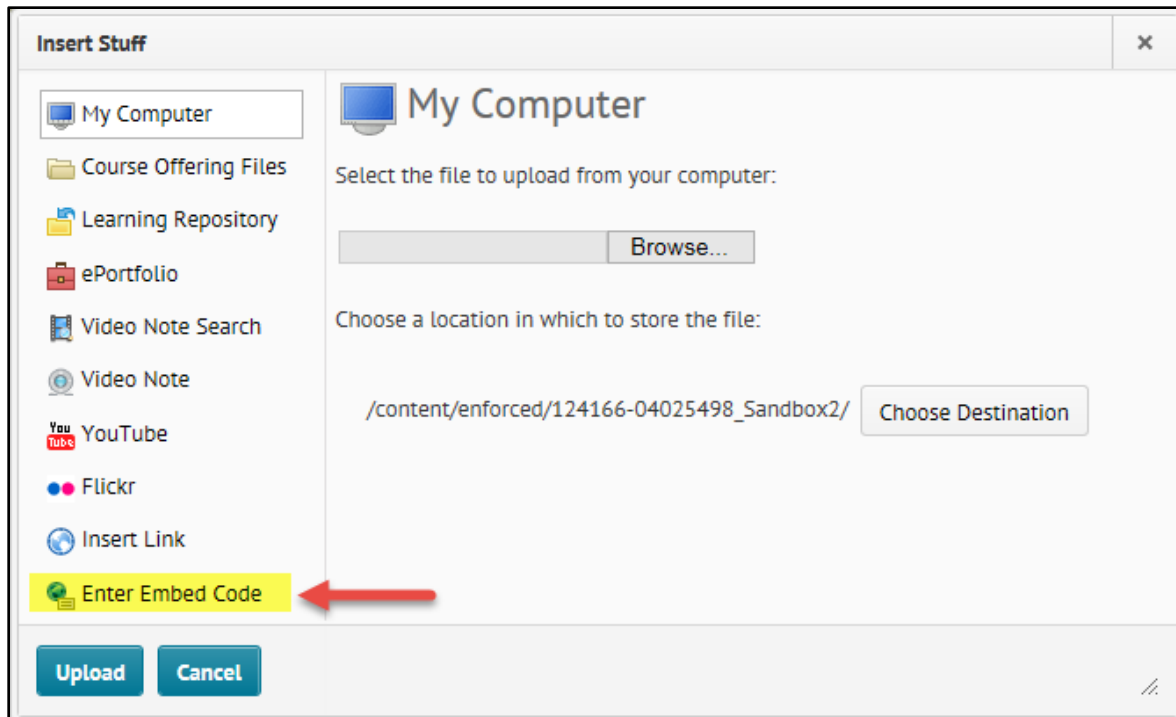

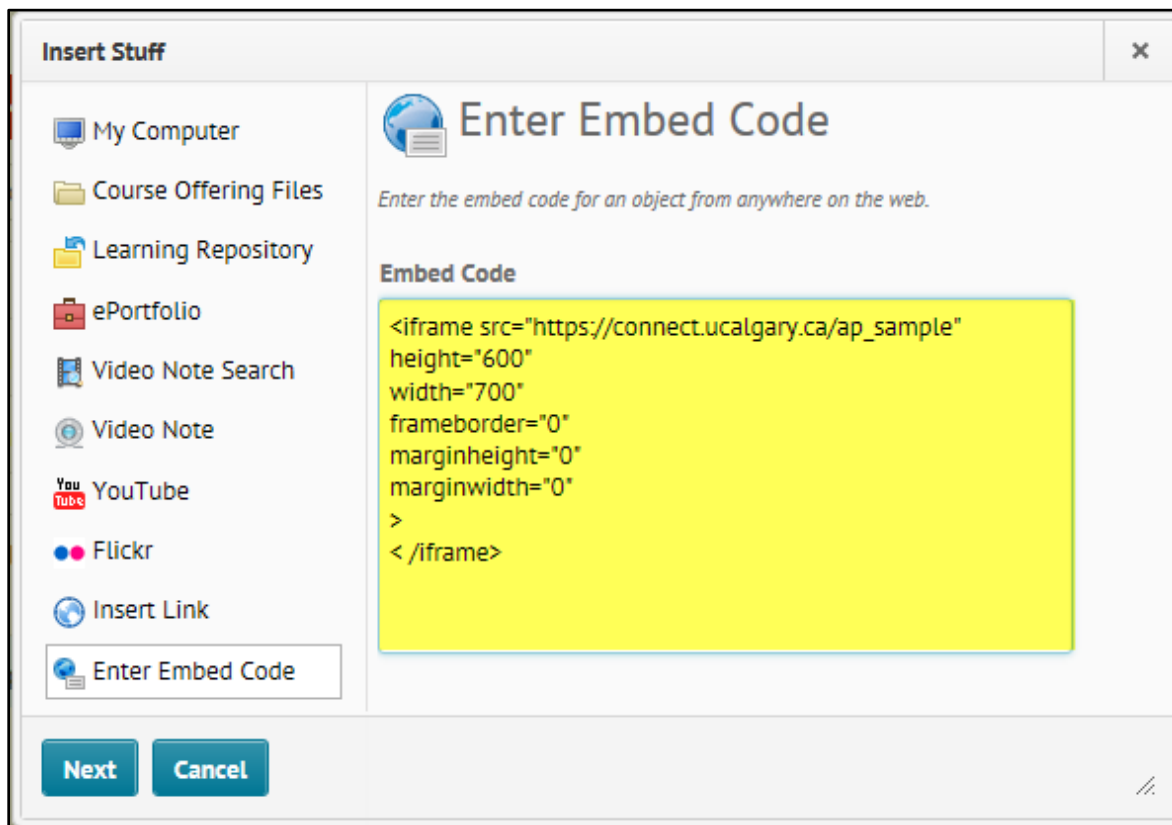

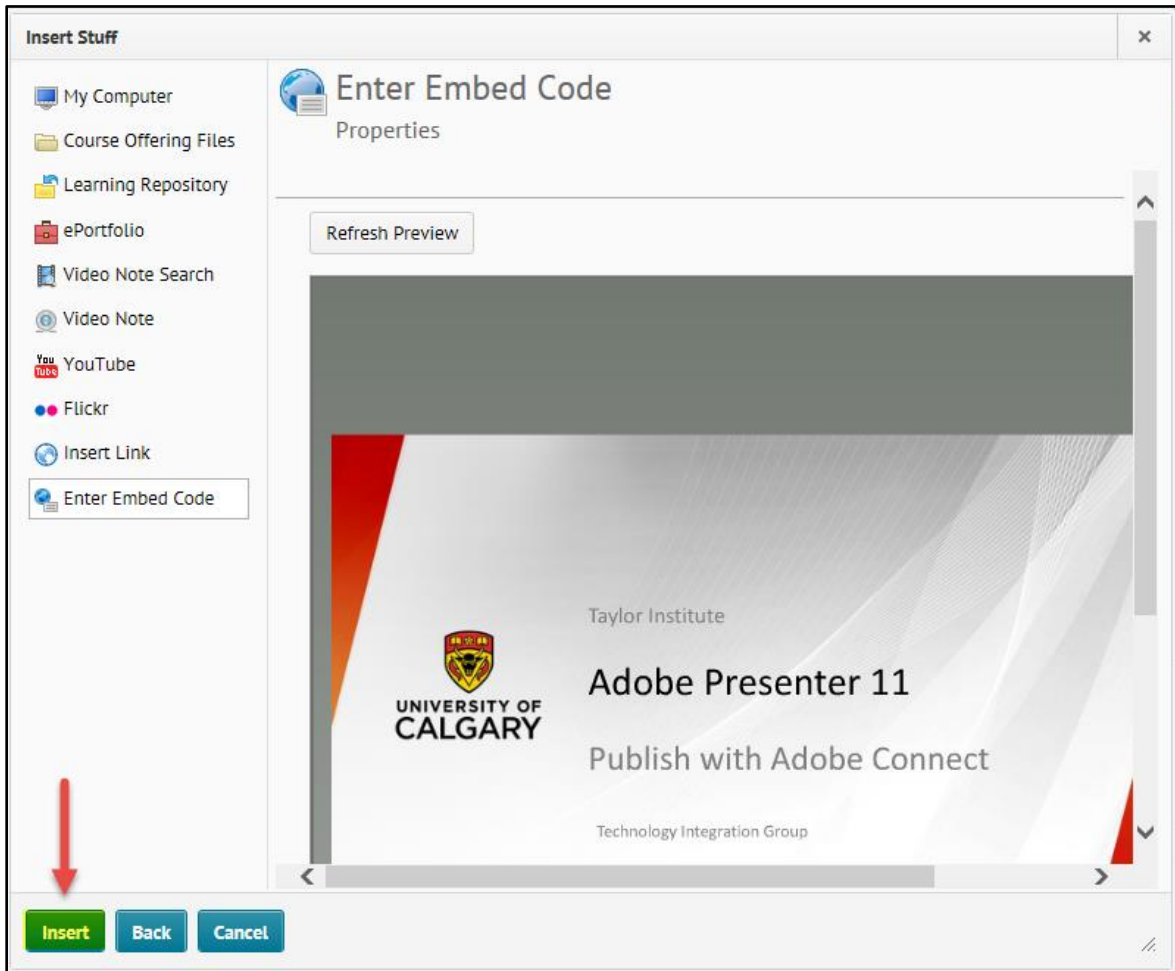
