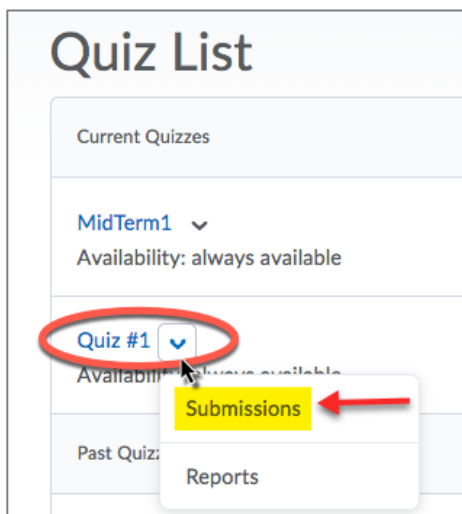


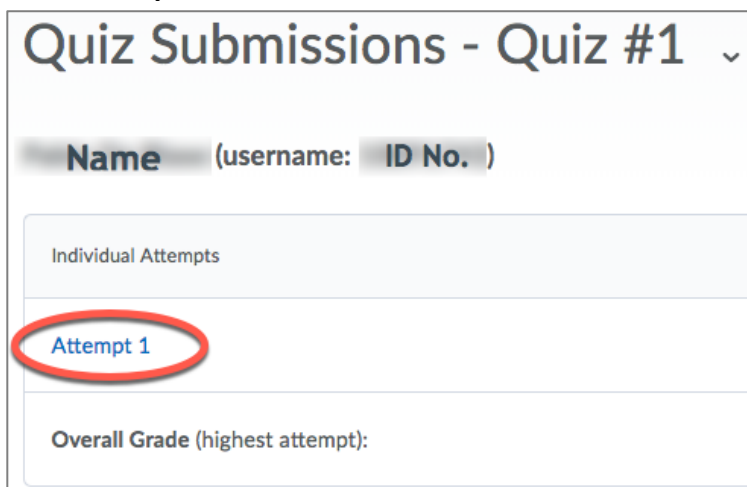
Students: How to View Quiz Scores with Answers
