Create and Join an Adobe Connect Meeting in D2L


This guide will show you how to set up and join an Adobe Connect Meeting room in D2L.

Creating a room in D2L

1. In the course you wish to create the room, select the following from the red navbar: **Communication > Online Rooms**



- 2. Choose New Room
- 3. Name your meeting room. Avoid using special characters (eg #, &, \$, %, etc.) as they may cause errors. It is recommended that you include the date of the session in the meeting name. Make sure **Connect** is listed as the **Service Provider**.
- 4. **IMPORTANT:** To ensure all students enrolled in the course can access the meeting room, please set the following options:
 - i) Choose "Public Room" under Room Visibility to allow access to all students in the course




- ii) Under **Availability**, set the **Start Date and Time** as well as **End Date and Time**.

 NOTE: These values are for display/ sorting purposes only and will not actually restrict access to the meeting room.
- iii) Ensure that Advanced Properties are visible by clicking on Show Advanced Properties.



iv) Under **Room Access**, ensure that the following is selected: **Anyone who has the URL for the meeting can enter the room**



5. Click the Save button.

Joining an Adobe Connect Meeting in D2L

A. Students and instructors can join an Adobe Connect meeting room by going to **Communication > Online Rooms**, then selecting the **Join** link. <u>NOTE</u>: Make sure **Connect** is listed as the **Service Provider**.




B. As instructor, you may also create a shortcut within a Content module for students.


To do so,


choose Online Rooms under Add Existing Activities,

choose the room to add,

then choose the **Details** option (not **Archives**).







To enter the meeting as a student, go to the **Content** module where the shortcut has been added. Click on the room **Details** link, then click
