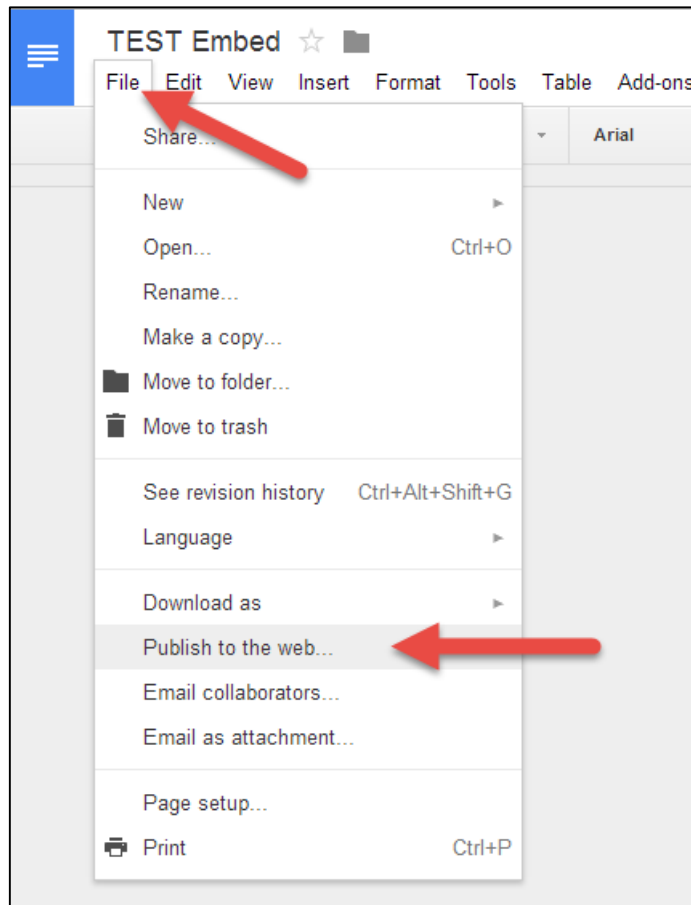


Embed a Google Document into Content

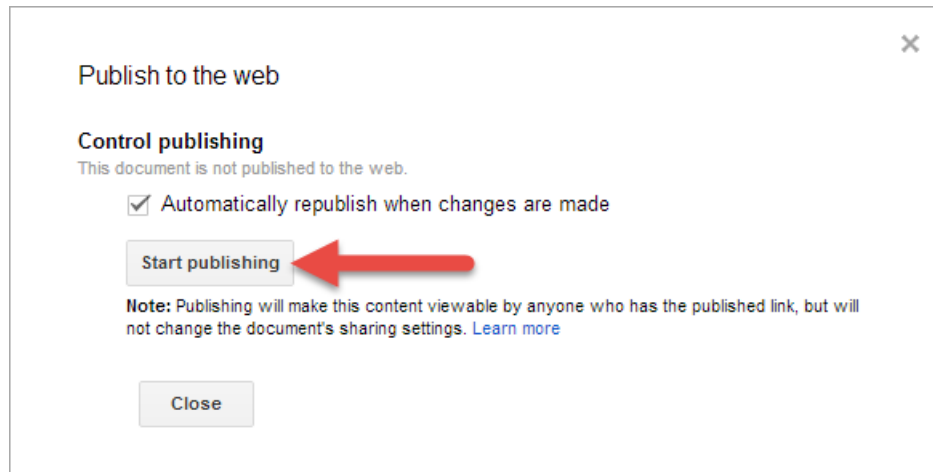

A Google Drive document can be embedded into Content using the HTML5 Editor. You may be either maintaining a document of your own course materials where changes can easily be updated to D2L automatically OR you are sharing the document with a group for the purpose of collaboration.

1. **Create** a Google Drive document
2. Click **File** → **Publish to the web**

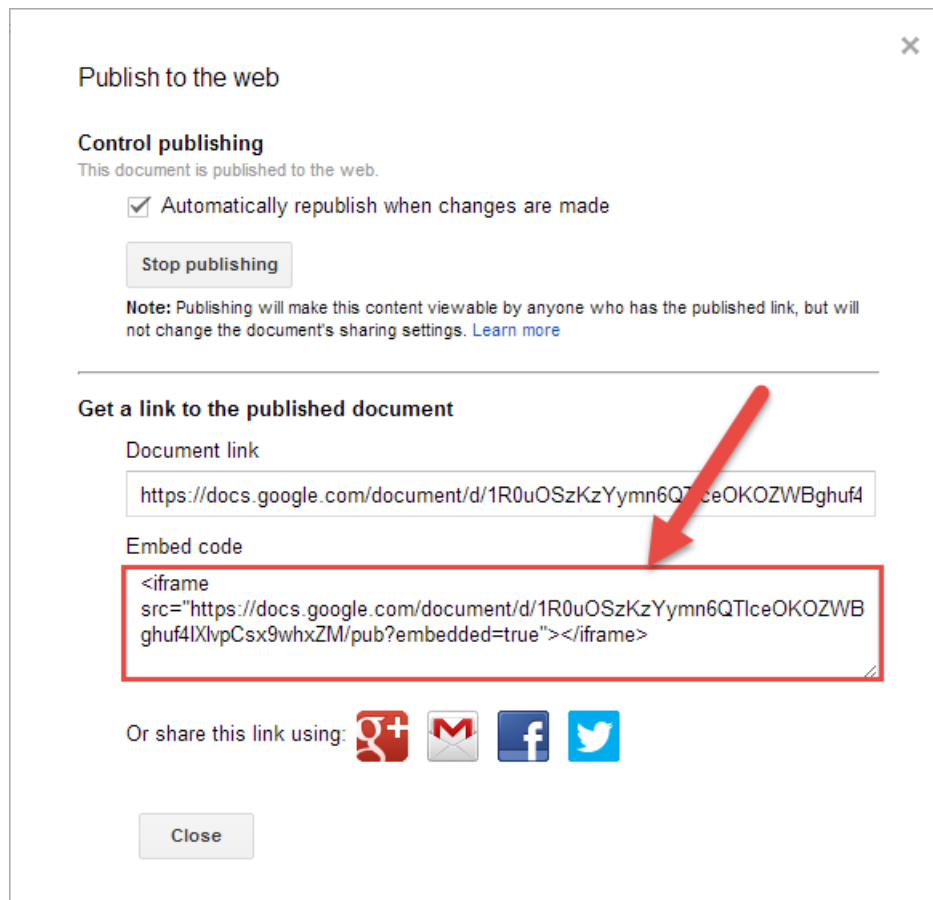


3. If this is the first time you're publishing the document, you will need to click **Start publishing**

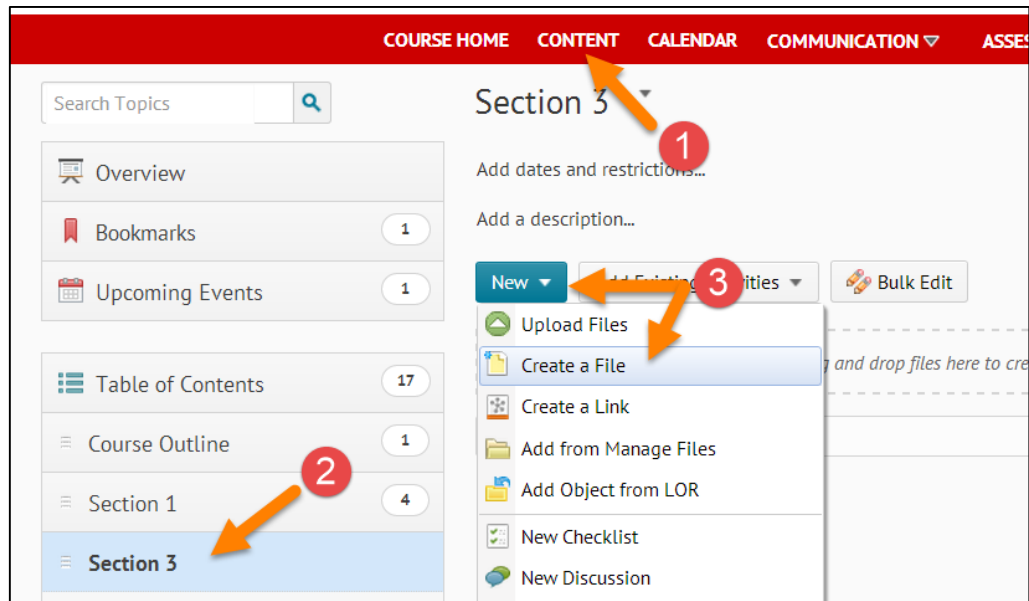


If you want the document to be updated automatically, leave the **Automatic republish when changes are made** checkbox checked.

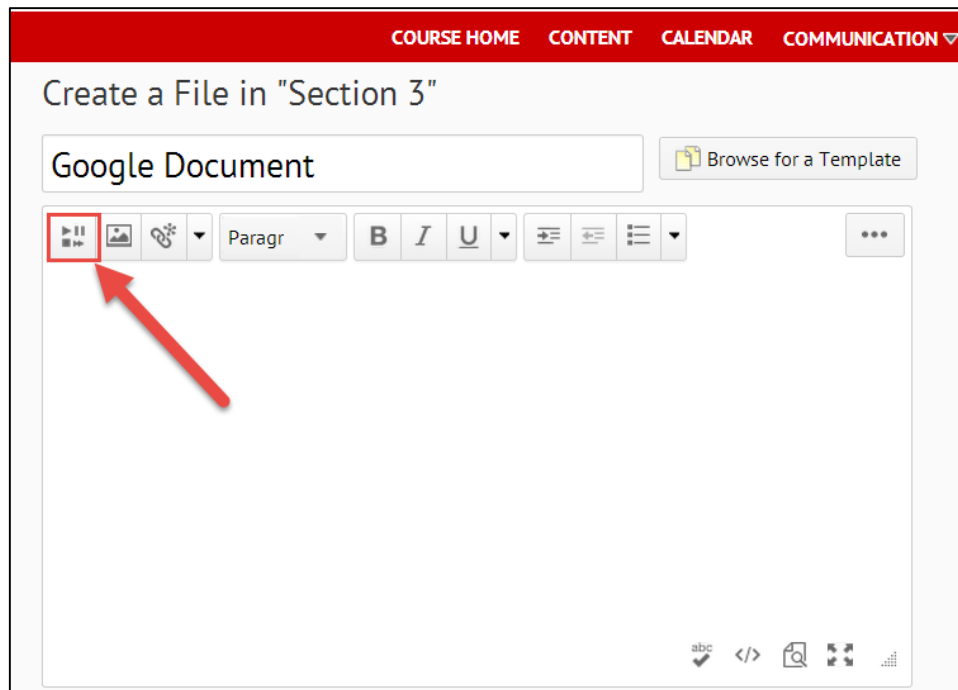
4. Click **OK** if prompted **Are you sure you want to publish this document?**
5. **Copy the Embed code**



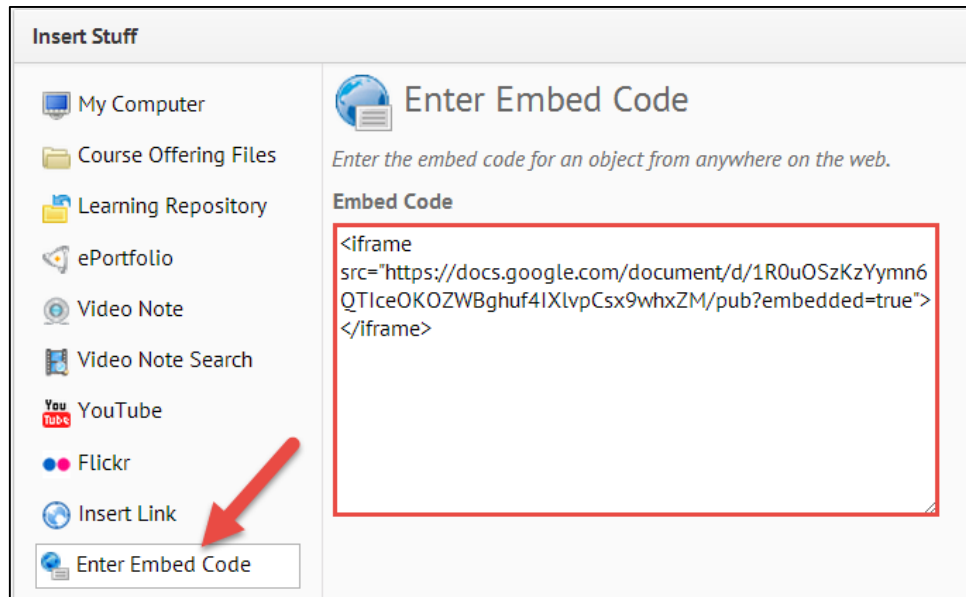
6. Go to D2L, and **Create a File**



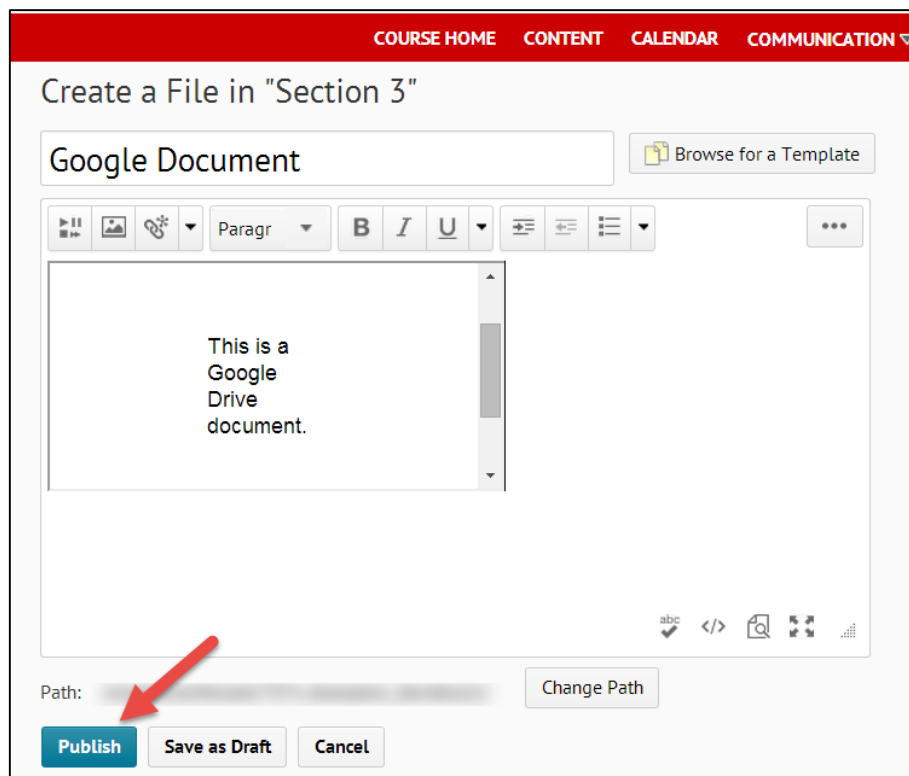
7. Click the **Insert Stuff** button in the HTML Editor



8. Click **Enter Embed Code** & paste the copied code into the open field



9. Click **Next** and **Insert**
10. The Google Drive document is now embedded into a frame within the HTML Editor.



Click **Publish** to finish
